

Termination of Pregnancy Service – Revised information below

We are pleased to confirm that from the 1st April 2017 a range of Termination of Pregnancy providers are available for you and your patients as listed below;

- British Pregnancy Advisory Service (BPAS)
- Chelsea and Westminster NHS Foundation Trust
- Marie Stopes International (MSI)
- National Unplanned Pregnancy Advisory Service (NUPAS)

TOP Service provision may include any one or more of the following;

- Pre TOP - Support, Advice and Assessment Appointment
- TOP procedure
- Aftercare/Post TOP Support and follow-up arrangements
- Post - Contraception

Eligibility Criteria

Women who are considering a termination of pregnancy and are registered with a GP in Ealing or the geographical area covered by North West London CCGs

Referral Exclusions are:

- Prisoner health
- Women ineligible for NHS treatment
- Women not registered with a GP or resident in the areas of any of the commissioning organisations
- Women post 24 weeks gestation
- Complex medical cases may be excluded in some settings as per the pre-existing conditions
- Women requiring an overnight stay

Central Booking Service (Termination of Pregnancy)

The British Pregnancy Advisory Service (BPAS) will be providing the Central Booking Service to coordinate clinic availability of all the providers listed above from 1st April 2017.

Imperial Healthcare Trust is no longer an AQP provider

From the 1st April 2017 Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust (ICHT) will only provide complex and > 24 weeks gestation Termination of Pregnancy services. Complex cases include any patient with comorbidities which include:

- Anaemia and bleeding disorders
- Asthma
- BMI > 40
- Cardiovascular or cerebrovascular disease
- Chronic disease with systemic illness
- Hypertension
- Lung disease
- Porphyria
- Seizure disorder uncontrolled by therapy
- Thyroid abnormalities

This means that patients should not be referred to ICHT for routine (<24weeks gestation, non-complex) terminations of pregnancy.
