ADVICE SERVICE

WGN Advice service, as part of Ascent consortium, provides free and confidential information, advice and support to women and girls experiencing domestic and sexual violence.

- Advice Line: provides free, confidential and accessible information and support, designed to enable callers to explore and have an understanding of the options available to them, in a safe non-judgmental space. Specialist information is available on a wide range of topics such as personal safety, housing, welfare benefits, legal options and processes, immigration and emotional wellbeing. The advice line will also signpost/refer to other specialist local services available under the Ascent Consortium.
- <u>Group Work:</u> Six sessions provided in a workshop format, focusing on different themes to rebuild confidence, emotional wellbeing and create awareness around healthy relationships. Groups will take place in the London borough of Ealing, Hounslow and Hillingdon.
- One to one support: Offering women and girls short term, holistic, face to face practical and emotional support within an empowering framework. This includes safety planning, risk assessment, support to access health, therapeutic, legal and any other appropriate specialist services, as well as offering emotional support, with the overall aim of empowering the client to enhance her safety and regain control over her life.
